

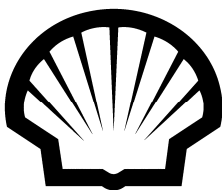

## The AIYF Singing Group

Following from the pilot singing and music project in Northfield during the 2009 Aberdeen International Youth Festival (in partnership with the Little Larks Music Company from Glasgow) AIYF are pleased to be able to expand the project by creating a regular youth singing group in partnership with Northfield Community Centre.



**The signing group for all abilities meet at Northfield Community Centre, Byron Square every Thursday night from 6pm – 7pm.** Young people aged Primary 5 to Secondary 3 are invited to come along and work with the AIYF Music Team to write their own music, sing in groups and as soloists. The music team is made up of

three experienced local singing tutors and musicians and will introduce the participants to different and fun ways to develop and enjoy singing. The course is designed to be exciting and challenging and will explore a wide range of music including chart music and traditional songs. The sessions will also feature opportunities for self expression through learning about song and composing exciting music.

This course is aimed at all abilities, from those who have never sung to those that have sung for a while in groups and on stage. During the course, the whole company will play games, learn and rehearse music, while also preparing for performance opportunities.

The Singing Group is led by 3 professionally trained music and singing tutors Jayne Carmichael, Amy Beth Smith and Christopher Barr. All are students or graduates of the University of Aberdeen Music Department and have worked with many local choirs and schools as well as the National Youth Choir of Scotland. They have all received disclosure checks enabling them to work with young people.

The group would also welcome any older volunteers from senior secondary pupils and other adults. Just come along or contact the AIYF office using the details on the registration form.

- The group will get together each **Thursday night during term time from 6 – 7pm.**
- Open to young people aged Primary 5 To 3<sup>rd</sup> Year of Secondary School.
- The course will be held at the Northfield Community Centre, Byron Square, Aberdeen, AB16 7LL
